Protecting Porn, Protects Predators

Another little girl has been stolen and murdered. How many more babies must die before we admit the cause of these horrifying cases? How long will the legal defenders of pornography, especially child pornography, deny the blood on their hands? How many more little girls must be butchered before those who inspire these subhumans begin to see what their deliberate perversion of the First Amendment has done to our country and its people?

Have none of these pornographers and their defenders read Ted Bundy's confession? Or is it that they are so ideologically driven that they don't care? Do none of them have little girls who they cherish more than life itself?

It includes "mental health" workers who support spurious insanity pleas. These predators aren't insane, they are evil. Live with it. These people are evil to the core.

That man, Cary Stayner, who killed those women in Yosemite, said it made him feel "in control" when he killed them. That is not a sign of insanity; it is a sign that he is so evil he should be executed. If he is ever "healed" and released, he will do it again.

We have allowed predators all the rights, while their victims have none. We give them victim compensation, but it is hard to spend money when you are dead. Women and children who have had their throats cut, been strangled, bludgeoned or shot after having been hideously brutalized, do have a problem making use of that "blood" money.

The O.J. Simpson travesty is the poster trial for American injustice. If an accused murderer has money and can afford the dream team, attorneys will prostitute themselves to secure an acquittal. If a predator belongs to a politically "hot" group, lawmakers, attorneys and activists will present him as a downtrodden victim.

We can't stop these horrifying episodes. We have created a crop of sexual predators, the number and viciousness of which are beyond our capacity to comprehend, much less control.
